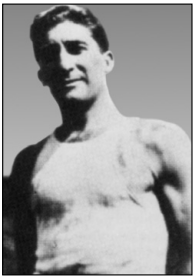

The Rudin Trophy is given in memory of their beloved father, grandfather and great grandfather, a long distance runner for the Pastime Athletic Club in the Bronx between 1917 and 1923.



Samuel Rudin (1896-1975)

An avid long distance runner and civic leader, Samuel Rudin rose from humble beginnings on New York's Lower East Side to become one of New York's major builders and owners of real estate. Rudin joined the Pastime Athletic Club in the Bronx in 1917 while a student at City College and competed in long distance races as a member of the Club through 1923. In 1925, he founded the Rudin Management Company, a real estate firm which presently owns and manages 20 multi-story apartment houses and 16 office buildings in Manhattan. Samuel Rudin was actively involved with many charitable organizations in New York City, including the United Jewish Appeal, City College Fund and the Boy Scouts of America. In 1967, he was awarded an honorary Doctor of Laws degree by Iona College in New Rochelle, New York. Today the Rudin family continues to play a major philanthropic role in New York City and is proud to have been a sponsor of the New York City Marathon since its inception as a five borough race in 1976.

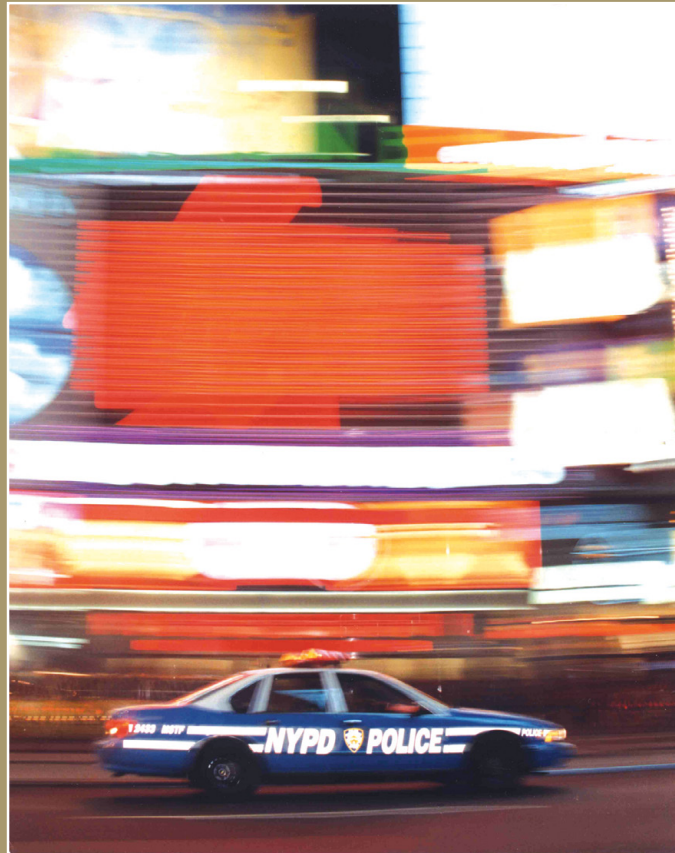

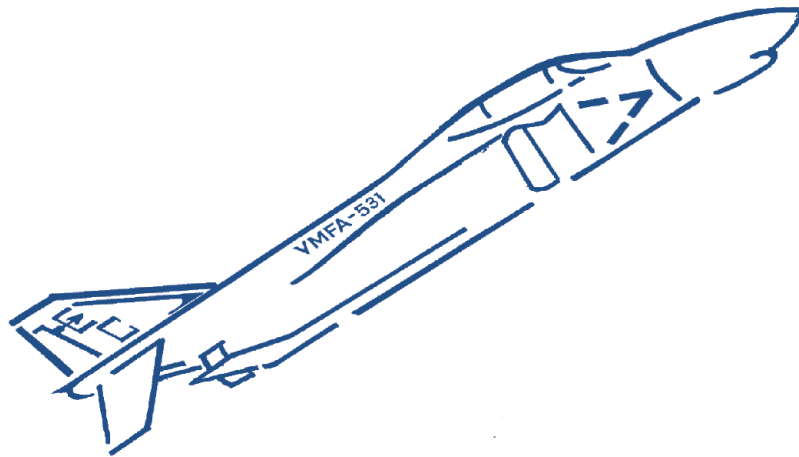

Officer Shafidya currently serves as a youth officer, conducting home visits for at-risk youths and first-time offenders working to combat youth recidivism. Officer Shafidya also oversees the Explorers Program, the

Scared Straight Program and presents at PTA meetings, informing school administrators and parents about drug and gang awareness.

CRIMINALIST III KATHARINE FERRANTE

OFFICE OF THE CHIEF MEDICAL EXAMINER LIAISON UNIT/FORENSIC INVESTIGATIONS UNIT:

Criminologist Katharine Ferrante helped establish the Forensic Investigations Unit, which interfaces between the NYPD and the Office of Chief Medical Examiner. Ms. Ferrante is responsible for training the Unit and establishing a protocol for the vetting of DNA evidence. The unit received a citation thanks to her efforts as a proactive, problem-solving individual

An auto mechanic since 1988, Mr. Kara maintains the various computerized tracking systems utilized to maintain the fleet of NYPD vehicles, leveraging new tools including Vehicle Allocation & Control and EZ Pass databases.

BROOKLYN SOUTH COMMUNITY AFFAIRS:

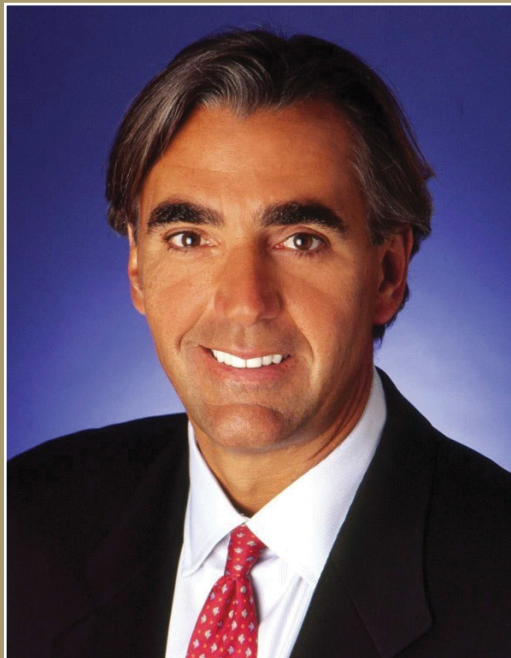

A DECADE OF RESULTS...

ONE DECADE AGO, the New York City Police Department found itself on the front lines of the global fight against terrorism. After September 11th, New York City faced the very real possibility that more attacks could take place at any moment. The Police Department needed to adapt to this new reality. In addition to crime-fighting, it formally adopted the mission of counterterrorism.

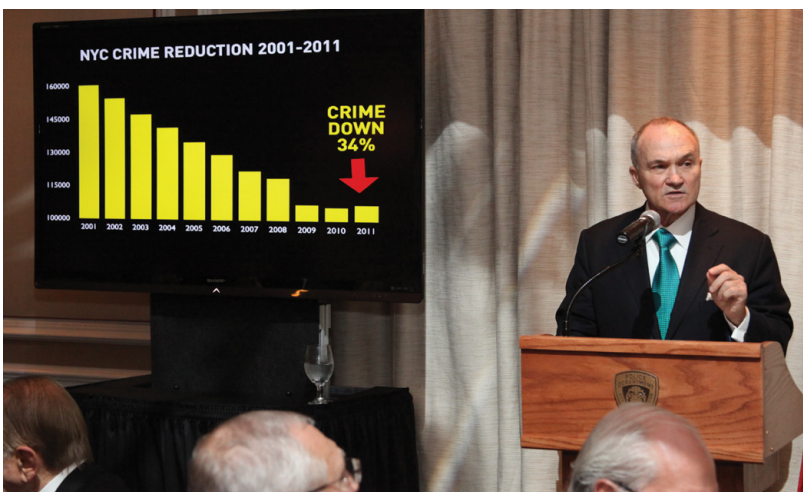
...A VISION FOR THE FUTURE

Under the leadership of **POLICE COMMISSIONER RAYMOND W. KELLY**, the NYPD embarked on a broad campaign of strategic and technological reform aided by the New York City Police Foundation. Today, the result is a Police Department utterly transformed—and a city that's safer because of it.

Protecting New York in the post-9/11 era has necessitated a dramatic expansion of the NYPD's counterterrorism capacity. The Police Foundation has been a proud partner in innovation, with significant contributions to the Department's new Counterterrorism Division, including state-of-the-art equipment. Since 2003 the International Liaison Program, funded by the Police Foundation, has enabled the NYPD to set its defensive sights beyond our borders. The program stations NYPD officers in 11 foreign cities, in addition to postings within key national and international law enforcement organizations such as U.S. Customs, the Joint Terrorism Task Force, and Interpol. These liaisons seek to learn practical lessons from terrorism-related events and ask "the New York question":

How can these lessons be applied to New York City?

Time and again, as in the wake of bombings in London, Madrid and Istanbul and the three-day terrorist siege in Mumbai, NYPD liaison officers have been the first or among the first foreign law-enforcement personnel on the scene, gathering information that leads to new insights for operations, preventing attacks, and the hardening of sensitive New York City targets.

In 2003, for example, the Tel Aviv liaison officer traveled to Istanbul to gather information on a series of truck bombings that had killed more than 50 people and wounded more than 700. With two synagogues among the bombers’ targets, the liaison’s analyses of methods of attack informed protective measures subsequently undertaken by the NYPD at major New York synagogues. Later, in 2008, three NYPD liaison officers traveled to India in the wake of a three-day ordeal with heavily armed terrorists in Mumbai. These officers supplied the NYPD with details that provided the underpinning for tactical drills and tabletop simulations based on the attacks. Shortly thereafter, the Department started training recruits in heavy weapons and videotaping NYC hotel interiors for training and preparedness.

The Police Foundation has also aided the Department’s counterterrorism efforts by making possible such specialized acquisitions as vapor wake detection Labradors. These bomb-sniffing dogs can detect airborne particles from explosives up to ten minutes after a person carrying or wearing them has left an area – and track a suspect even through crowded city streets and train stations.

Here at home, the Foundation helped bring about one of the Department’s most dramatic innovations by providing seed money for the Real Time Crime Center, which provides vital support to detectives investigating violent crimes such as shootings and murders. The RTCC is linked to a massive data warehouse that serves as a virtual “NYPD Google,” with billions of pieces of information detailing everything from 911 calls to criminals’ tattoos. The ongoing collection, digitization, and analysis of data by the RTCC make it possible to “connect the dots” in an investigation in real time, greatly expediting the work of detectives in the field.



With the Police Foundation's help, the NYPD continues to create an informational infrastructure in which more traditional programs and cutting-edge initiatives work together in synergy. A call, for example, might come in to the Crime Stoppers tip line providing a single piece of information on an armed robbery suspect, such as a nickname. In the past, a tip like that might well have turned into a dead end if a detective didn't have the good luck to stumble across a match in one of millions of files. Now, however, a single data point like a tattoo or a nickname can instantly call up a photo, a full name, and an address – along with a host of corresponding information on everything from arrest records to known associates, literally creating a picture of where a suspect might be hiding.

With the advent of new technology, traditional programs like Crime Stoppers continue to thrive. Police Foundation support for Crime Stoppers and Gun Stop has helped the NYPD remove thousands of dangerous criminals and illegal weapons from our streets. With the ability to take anonymous messages through text and email messages and linkage to data analyses through the Real Time Crime Center, Crime Stoppers is more effective than ever.

In addition to the Real Time Crime Center, the Police Foundation has demonstrated an overarching commitment to helping the NYPD upgrade its technological capacity across the board, assisting in the digitization of crime scene evidence collection, such as the photographs taken by the Crime Scene Unit, and the updating of latent print operations. These efforts continue – aided by a major contribution by JP Morgan Chase & Co., the

largest in the Foundation's history – with the Foundation's current drive to expand the Department's use of information technology through new equipment and personnel services that include 1000 new computers, installation of laptops in patrol cars, and new security software for the RTCC.

A VISION FOR THE NYPD NYPD2020

To ensure that New York remains one of the world's safest cities, the Police Foundation is seeking support for NYPD2020, a vision, road-map, and implementation plan that will prepare the NYPD for the challenges of protecting our city over the next decade.

BACKGROUND: Ten years ago, the Police Foundation and the NYPD took a strategic look at the challenges the NYPD would face in policing a post 9/11 New York City. Specific program areas included the development of a modern infrastructure for the NYPD's critical information technology systems and the development of state-of-the-art counterterrorism initiative. The following decade produced record breaking reductions in crime.

NYPD2020: The NYPD and the Police Foundation are taking a similar look to the future by conducting a comprehensive analysis of where the department needs to be in the year 2020, and an operational strategy to begin building the department around that vision.

The Department's senior staff has identified 11 critical aspirations in the areas of talent, collaboration, and crime fighting. The next phase involves implementing strategic programs designed to make the next ten years and beyond even safer.



Because over 90% of the NYPD budget is dedicated to personnel, there is little left for innovative programs. With your support, the Police Foundation has been able to raise funds to help:

- Assign NYPD intelligence officers as International Liaisons to 11 terrorist hotspots around the world to gather global intelligence
- Remove thousands of dangerous felons from our streets through the Crime Stoppers Program
- Build the most advanced crime-fighting data warehouse in the U.S., the Real Time Crime Center

Crime-Fighting

CRIME STOPPERS offers rewards up to \$2,000 for anonymous information that leads to the arrest and indictment of a violent felon. Tips are submitted by calling 1-800-577-TIPS, texting “TIP577” plus message to “CRIMES” (274637), or visiting NYPDCrimeStoppers.com. Tips to Crime Stoppers have helped solve over 5,100 crimes, including more than 1,400 homicides.

To preserve the anonymity of callers, rewards must be funded through private donations rather than public dollars.

OPERATION GUN STOP offers rewards of \$1,000 for anonymous information that leads to the arrest of individuals in possession of illegal hand guns. Calls to 1-866-GUN-STOP have led to over 5,300 arrests and the removal of more than 3,060 illegal weapons since the program’s inception in 2001.

REAL TIME CRIME CENTER (RTCC) transformed the way police departments use information technology to fight crime. Data that once took weeks to process—such as arrest records, mug shots, warrant information—can now be provided to investigators in the field in “real time”.

OUR PROGRAMS

Counterterrorism

INTERNATIONAL LIAISON PROGRAM (ILP) posts Intelligence Division officers to 11 foreign cities to form relationships with local police agencies, compare best practices, visit the scenes of terrorist attacks, and ensure that available information regarding terrorist attacks is quickly transmitted back to the Counterterrorism Unit.

VAPOR WAKE DETECTION labradors are trained to detect airborne particles from explosives that have passed through an area, and track a suspect through crowded city streets and train stations. Vapor Wake Labradors can detect mobile explosives up to 10 minutes after leaving an area.

Community Relations

NYPD SOCCER & CRICKET leagues were established in an effort to reach out to New York's young male Muslim community. The goal is to increase the lines of communication and generate understanding with the participants, their friends, families and the entire community.

Innovative Policing

NYPD2020 is a vision and implementation plan to prepare the NYPD for the challenges of protecting our city over the next decade. The Police Foundation is helping the NYPD conduct a comprehensive analysis of where the department needs to be in the year 2020, and will create an operational strategy to build the department around that vision.

TECHNOLOGY upgrades that provide millions of dollars worth of essential equipment and personnel services to NYPD systems; including: computer systems and infrastructure upgrades in 29 critical NYPD facilities, linking patrol cars to the Department's information network with vehicle laptops, and a department-wide security upgrade to protect sensitive NYPD data.

SCHOLARSHIP & PROFESSIONAL EXPERTISE initiatives are designed to elevate the professionalism of NYPD personnel through higher education (Harvard, SUNY Albany), training programs (Operation Sentry), and outside expertise (Forensic Lab Scientists, Intellectual Property Lawyers).

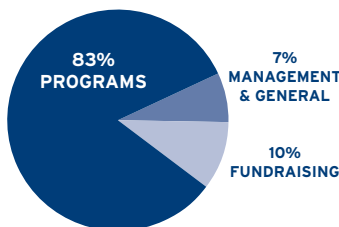

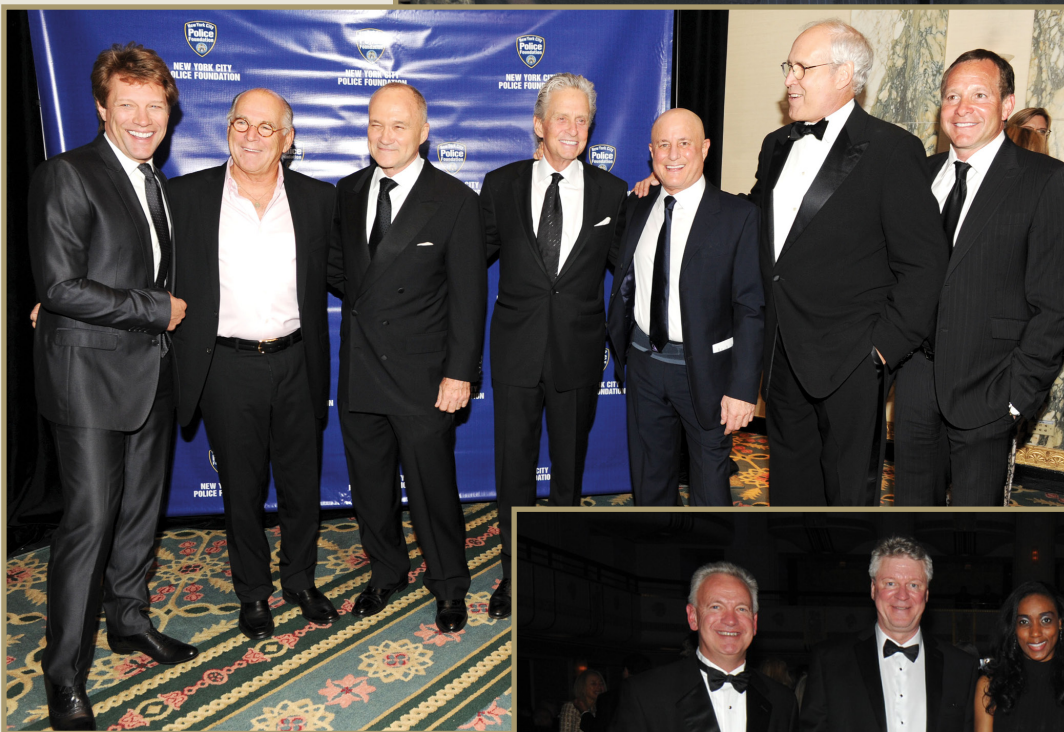
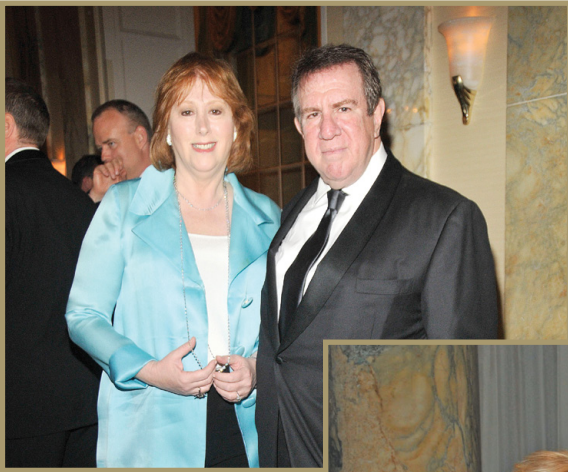

On this special occasion, I want to thank the supporters of the New York City Police Foundation for everything you've helped the police department to achieve. In the early morning on February 20, 2011, two West Point cadets on a repelling expedition became stranded on an 18-in ledge on Storm King Mountain, which stands 1,300 feet above the Hudson River. Clinging to a tree as winds increased up to 50mph and temperatures dropped below freezing, the cadets called for help and local police triangulated their cellphone signal to find them. However, neither the fire departments nor the State Police were able to reach the ledge.

The NYPD was called to help and deployed a Bell 412 helicopter with Aviation Unit Det. Steve Browning (pilot), Det. Mike Sileo (co-pilot),

Det. Chris Condon, Det. Fernando Almeida, and Det. William Stevens. Using night vision equipment and battling gale-force winds, Browning was able to position the helicopter close enough to the ledge. Eventually, medic Chris Condon was lowered and helped the first cadet to safety. The high winds made it impossible to grab the second cadet immediately, so Condon stayed with him for nearly an hour until the helicopter could return.

The five NYPD crew members received the 2011 "Cop of the Year" Award for their heroic rescue.
